WHAT IS THE EYSET PROJECT?

The EYSET project (2022-2024) is an Erasmus+ project co-funded by the European Union.

The project aims to empower youth organizations and youth workers to enhance the social inclusion, fast track integration into the labour market and spirit of social entrepreneurship among young people with and without disabilities in the tourism value chain.

The goal is also to change the perception towards young people with disabilities, who will be instead seen, thanks to the project, as young people who are actually able to play a leading role in the context of tourism and social entrepreneurship.
